

## **DR HOOMAN SOLEYMANI MAJD (MD, MRCOG, BSCCP)**

Dr Hooman Soleymani majd started his obstetrics and gynaecology career in London, he then moved to Oxford and completed a structured postgraduate training programme. During the course of training he obtained his MRCOG, which culminated in a CCT in obstetrics and gynaecology. He then completed a further three years of sub-specialty training in gynaecology oncology. Dr Soleymani majd is a consultant gynaecological oncology surgeon at Oxford University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, based at the Churchill Cancer Centre. He is the clinical governance lead for the gynaecology oncology department. He is a BSCCP accredited colposcopist and trainer, as well as a member of the British Gynaecological cancer society (BGCS).

Dr Soleymani majd is an accomplished and experienced advanced laparoscopic surgeon. He performs complex radical laparoscopic surgeries for uterine and cervical cancer. He also has a special interest in performing ultra-radical surgery for ovarian cancer and pelvic exenterative surgery. His skill set includes upper abdominal surgery, liver mobilization and diaphragmatic reconstruction. He also has a particular surgical interest in treating patients with abnormally invasive placenta's (AIP).

He has active involvement in teaching registrars/fellows and medical students from Oxford University and has been a faculty member and demonstrator for a number of years at the annual BSGE Cadaveric dissection course. He has published many papers and has been an invited speaker at various international congresses and performed a number of live surgeries. He is part of an Oxford research group that has a special interest in developing new surgical techniques in ultra-radical surgery for advanced ovarian cancer.
